SABSE has created successful partnerships with SPS, community organizations and churches in conducting workshops for school leaders, teachers, parents and students. The Seattle Alliance of Black Educators will elect new officers to serve a two year term at the next General Business Meeting to be held on the third Tuesday in March. (March 16, 2010) consistent with the By-Laws and NABSE guidelines. The elections will be held at the end of the general meeting on March 16. Open positions: President, President Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, commission Chairperson. All members attending the general meeting will be eligible to vote provided their dues are current or paid before voting. Installation of Officers will be held at the end of the meeting.

President: *The president shall have all powers and duties appropriate to the office of President. The President shall appoint the chairpersons of all standing and ad hoc committees, and shall establish other committees as needed. The President shall designate a Parliamentarian to preside at all business meetings and a Historian. The president shall vote only in case of a tie.*

President Elect: *The President Elect shall assume the office of President upon the expiration of the president's term. In the absence or disability of the president, the President-Elect shall perform the duties and exercise the powers of the President.*

Secretary: *The Secretary shall keep minutes of the Executive Committee, the Executive Board and Membership meetings and shall perform other appropriate duties and functions as assigned by the President.*

Treasurer: *The treasurer shall be the Chairperson of the Budget Committee which shall study all official audit reports and make recommendation to the Alliance and shall serve on the Audit Committee. The treasurer in accordance with sound fiscal management procedures and policies as established by the Executive Board shall execute those procedures for signing with the President and disbursement of checks.*

Commission Chairperson: *The duty of the Commission Chairperson will be to conduct the meetings and coordinate all other activities of the Commission; represent the Commission as a member of the Executive Board; and assume other duties as prescribed by the Executive Board. The Commission Vice Chairperson will act in the absence of the Commission Chairperson.*
